Afghan	*	not less than 45" wide x 60" long.
Cardigan	*	buttoned, zippered, or closable front with sleeves
Centre Piece	*	in needle work over 12" not over 36"
Coverlet	*	fabric layered, e.g. baby blanket, tufting, appliquéd work, etc. machine or hand done
Crib Size	*	able to cover standard size crib (not larger than 44" x 54")
Dish Garden	*	a number of different kinds of plants artistically grouped, grown in an open dish
Doily	*	12" and under
Double Bed Size	*	must be able to cover standard double bed
Knee Throw	*	not more than 45" x 48", excluding fringe
Mounted for Display	*	jewelry may be boxed or secured to fabric, Styrofoam, etc. doilies on contrasting background (paper, etc.)
Novice	*	professional who has never won a prize in any competition for the class of work specified
Poncho	*	pulls over head
Quilt	*	3 layers, top, filling, backing, quilting done by hand, stitched going through all layers
Shawl	*	triangle or square folded to triangle
Single Bed Size	*	able to cover standard single bed
Sleeveless Pullover	*	pulls over head, no sleeves
Stole	*	rectangle
Tea or Bridge Cloth	*	not more than 30"
Tablecloth	*	over 40"
Tenerife Vest	*	chicken scratch embroidery opening in front, sleeveless
Wall Hanging	*	must be ready to hang, not framed

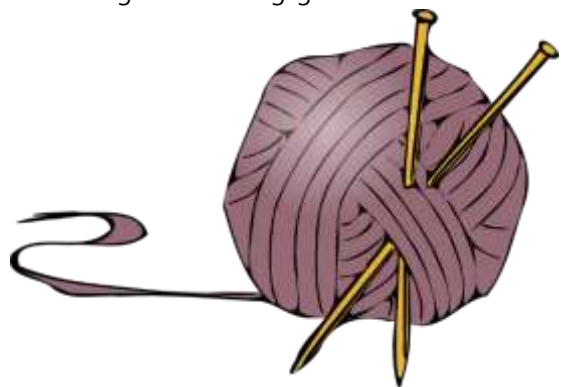
