Rules for Small Animals

1. O.A.S Membership Fee is required by everyone entering these classes
2. Animals not in show condition will be disqualified. Animals must be in cages by 8:30 am on Saturday. **You must bring in your entries on Friday between 1:00 and 4 pm or Saturday morning between 7:30 and 8:30 am. Please pay your livestock fee for your animals and membership by Thursday at 8:00 pm.**
3. All entries must be tagged and caged individually, unless they are being exhibited as pen; meat pen equals 3 birds or hen and chicks. Limit of 2 entries per class per exhibitor.
4. Register early to guarantee a cage, or bring your own.
5. In each of the AOV (any other variety) classes where there are 5+ entries of any one breed, with minimum of 3 exhibitors, this will constitute a class and will be judged accordingly.
6. All animals are to remain in the Barn till 8:00 pm on Sunday and failure to respect this rule results in forfeiture of prize money.
7. Barns will be closed at 8:00 pm to the public and exhibitors.
8. Sick or diseased animals will be disqualified & must be removed from the barns.

Class 4 – Stall Decorating Competition

- Certificates will be awarded for the best overall display of Goats, Sheep or Swine.
- Signs, decorations, educational display, cleanliness and overall attractiveness will be considered in judging.
- Pen allotment will be such that an exhibitor will have all his/her animals in adjacent pens to accommodate decorating



No livestock (dairy or beef cattle, sheep, bison or pigs) will be allowed entry to our fairgrounds unless they possess the approved (intact and undamaged) CFIA tag or PigTRACE identifier.

- It is against CFIA Regulations for Livestock to leave their premises without the proper tag or identifier.
- It is the responsibility of the owner and/or exhibitor of any livestock (dairy or beef cattle, sheep, bison) **to ensure that EVERY animal under their care, have the required approved tag as per CFIA regulations BEFORE entering our Fairgrounds.**
- It is the responsibility of the owner and/or exhibitor of pigs (including pot-bellied pigs and farmed wild boar NOTE: pot-bellied pigs can be microchipped) **to ensure that EVERY animal under their care, have the required approved identifier as per PigTRACE regulations BEFORE entering our Fairgrounds.**
- ANY livestock that does not have the required intact/undamaged CFIA approved tag or PigTRACE approved identifier **will not be allowed entry** to our fairgrounds and must leave immediately.
- If an Agricultural Society is required to provide a tag in the event that an animal loses their tag at the fair, then the **owner or exhibitor is responsible for applying the tag and ensuring that it is done in a safe manner.**

Agricultural Society staff or volunteers **MUST NOT apply or assist in applying the tag.** Furthermore, the Agricultural Society is not responsible for providing the pliers to apply the tag or facilities to restrain the animal while the owner/exhibitor applies the tag.

Additional Rules for Rabbits

1. Class 10 & Class 11 open to children, age 16 and under. No entry fee required.
2. Nursing Doe not eligible for regular Doe class.
3. Junior rabbits are 6 months of age or under.
4. Senior rabbits to be over 6 months.
5. Young to be 3-8 weeks of age
6. Rabbits under 3 weeks of age not permitted on Fair Grounds
7. In each of the pure breed or variety sections, where there are 5 or more entries of any one breed, with a minimum of 3 exhibitors, this will constitute a class and will be judged accordingly.
8. Meat pen consists of 3 rabbits (same breed and variety) and as close as possible in size, type and weight.
9. Meat class rabbits must weigh 3½ to 5 pounds – any rabbit over or under will be disqualified.
10. Carry-in entries not limited but coop space is limited.
11. Barns will be closed at 8:00 pm to the public and exhibitors.
12. Owners/Exhibitors **must** be present for judging; however, exceptions will be made for children and individuals competing in other Murillo Fair Events. Speak with Coordinator ahead of time.
