### Lawn Tractor Races

Saturday and Sunday

#### Safety

Required PPE: The following gear must be worn at all times when operating the racer.

Full fingered gloves

C.S.A./DOT approved helmet with visor or goggles

Long pants

Boots which cover ankles

Long sleeved shirt or jacket (coveralls are encouraged, but not required)

Attached tethered kill switch

Membership fee \$10

#### Classes

**Stock:** Stock tires, no driveline changes (pulleys, sprockets, gears, and belts must be in original configuration).

**Modified:** Tire and driveline changes are allowed. Must have a lawn tractor rear end, but belts, pulleys, chains, etc. can be changed.

**Outlaw Class:** So long as it's on a tractor frame, anything goes.

Alcohol is allowed in the Outlaw Class only, so long as there is a fire extinguisher attached and in plain sight on the tractor.

**Note:** If there is any suspicion that a tractor has been misidentified, it will be bumped up to the next class.

#### Basic Rules

1. All tractors, in all classes, must have a working tethered kill switch that is attached to the driver when on the track.
2. Tractors can have the decks on or off in all classes, so long as the blades are removed.
3. All tractors must have a visible number. Minimum 5" height is recommended. Must be on a contrasting background.
4. No drugs or alcohol shall be consumed before or during the race. Doing so will result in immediate disqualification from that event.

#### Race and Track Rules

1. Race line up, heats, and number of racers per heat will be decided on the day of the race.
2. All starts will be rolling (NASCAR type)
3. Intentional bumping/ramming of other racers will not be tolerated. Some light tapping is part of racing, but deliberate ramming will result in a single warning before disqualification. Reckless/dangerous driving will result in an automatic disqualification as well as the competitor being permanently banned from future races.
4. If a mower quits running during a race, it is the driver's responsibility to move the mower to a safe distance from the track.
5. All race participants must register no later than one hour prior to drivers meeting (time to be announced closer to race day), at which time registration will be closed.
